We then headed back over Chestnut Avenue passing the gates of Bushy House and after a further walk around Bushy Park made our way back to The Jolly Coopers where we were joined by nine other diners and enjoyed a selection of various delicious tapas dishes and, of course, a welcome pint/glass of wine.
